The fourth issue of the "Bulletin of FIPS" is devoted to various aspects in the field of protection of the interests of Russia in the process of economic and civil law circulation of the results of intellectual activity of military, special and dual designation. The feature topic of the issue is the 25th anniversary of the "Federal Agency for Legal Protection of the Results of Intellectual Activity of Military, Special and Dual Designation" (FALPIAR).

In his congratulatory address, the head of the Federal Service for Intellectual Property (Rospatent) Yu. The author provides a detailed analysis of the impact of strategic planning documents related to the issues of enforcement and protection of intellectual property, and also provides statistical information on the range of work being carried out.

In the columns of this issue the employees of FSBI "FALPIAR" disclose aspects of the activities

of the institution from its creation to the present, including paying attention to such problematic issues as the analysis of changes to the Civil Code that came into force in 2022 in the part of distribution of rights to intellectual property.

Article by N. Tsykorin "Formation of a mechanism for expert-analytical support of scientific and technical projects" reveals the importance and timeliness of the pilot application of a mechanism of expert-analytical support of scientific and technical projects that involve conducting research and development, production engineering and bringing high-tech products to the market.

An array of changes in regulatory acts and the law enforcement practice require the updating of programs and methods of teaching such disciplines as "innovation theory" and "intellectual property". Therefore, we give in this issue of the journal an article by M. Osipova, where the author reports the successful implementation of a project-oriented education model at the Yaroslav the Wise Novgorod State University in collaboration with FSBI "FALPIAR" and shares examples from practice.

Traditionally, the editorial staff of the journal focuses on inventors. For them, we continue the series "In aid of the inventor," which provides visual information on how the procedures for registering a disposal of or transfer of exclusive right and for registering a computer program, database and integrated circuit topography has changed.
